### Due Soon: California Pay Data Reporting

California employers of 100 or more employees and/or 100 or more workers hired through labor contractors must annually file pay data reports with the Civil Rights Department (CRD). Reports covering calendar year 2022 are due May 10, 2023. Employers can submit their reports through CRD's portal now.



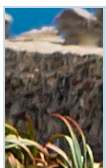
