Location: 39141 Civic Center Drive, Ste. 250, Fremont , CA 94538.

Community: Fremont is a diverse community and a progressive city with a population of over 208,000 people, making it the fourth largest in the San Francisco Bay Area, and 14th largest in California. The East Bay city is one of the most culturally diverse communities in the country with over 100 different languages spoken. Fremont is home to the largest concentration of Afghans in the United States and has a notable concentration of South Asians. The largest ethnic groups are Chinese, Indians, and Filipinos. Fremont and nearby Union City have fairly large numbers of Pacific Islanders, Cubans and Puerto Ricans, Spanish and Portuguese, and a small number of American Indians. Fremont also has a large deaf community, in large part because it is home of the Northern California campus of the California School for the Deaf.

Public Transportation: The facility is adjacent to the Fremont BART Station, no more than a five-minute walk.

Parking: Free parking is offered to tenants and visitors.

Accessibility: The facility is a grade A building that is ADA and Unruh Civil Rights Act compliant.
